

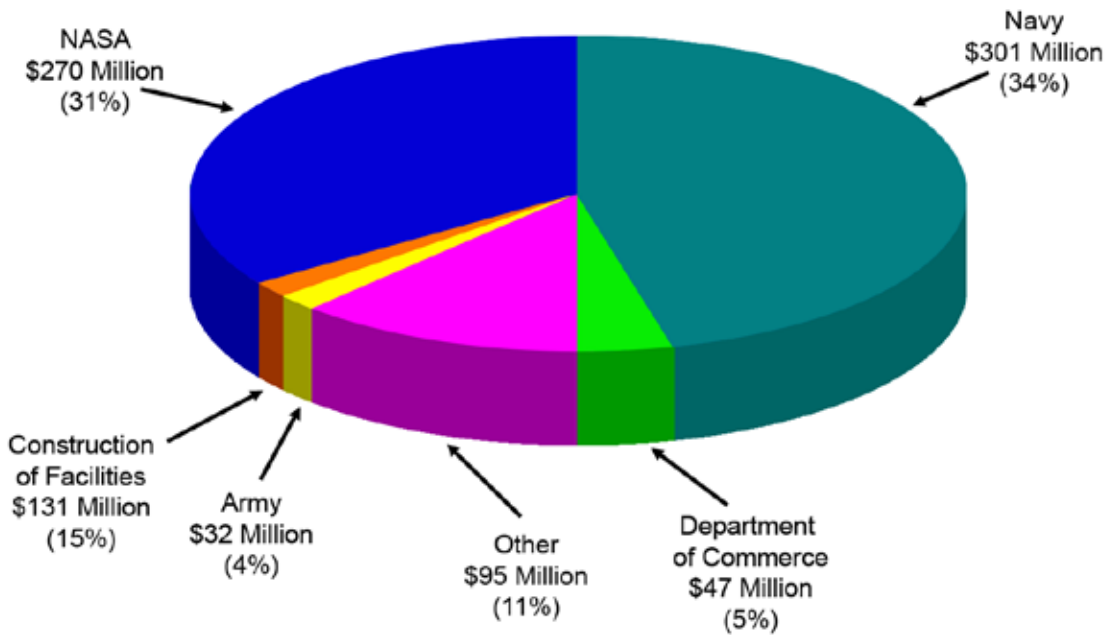


Stennis Space Center 2007 Economic Impact

Economic Viewpoint

NASA's Stennis Space Center is a significant source of employment and income in the local area. If SSC had not been in operation in 2007, the direct and indirect impact would have decreased considerably in terms of employment and revenue loss. The direct economic impact of the center in a 50-mile radius is calculated at \$622 million.

Direct Global Economic Impact \$876 Million



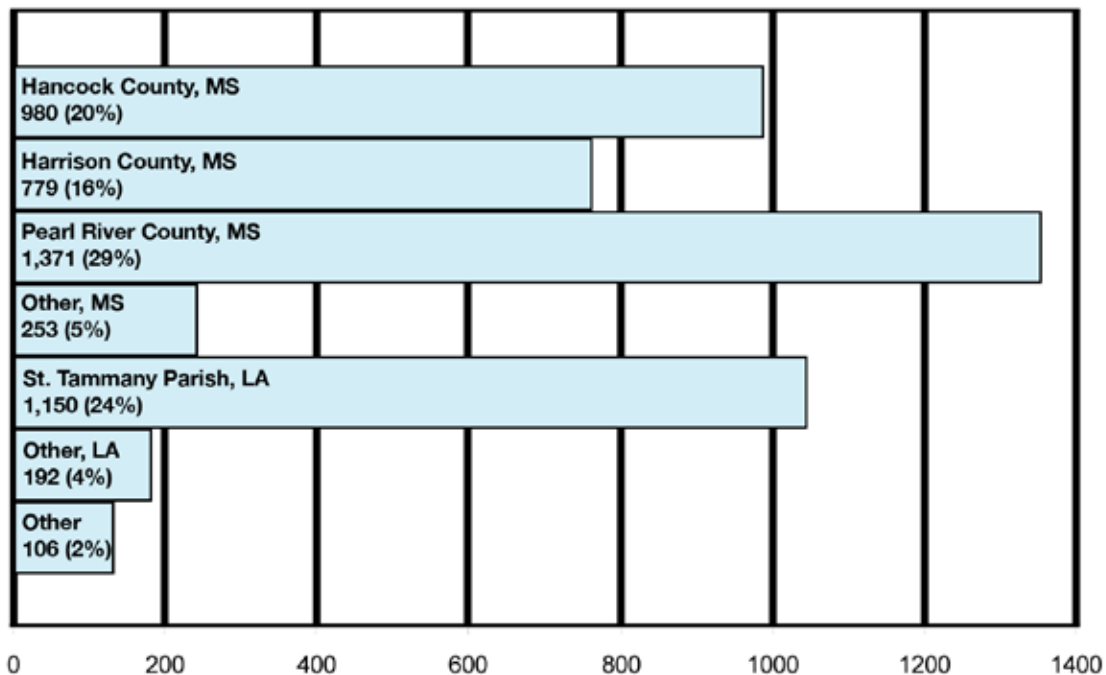
