NLR carries out research and development activities covering a wide range of technological areas, to meet present and future requirements. NLR is mainly active in civil and military aeronautics and spaceflight.

As the central institute in the Netherlands for aerospace research, NLR owns and operates several dedicated research facilities. By carrying out research programmes, the NLR staff keeps abreast of developments and creates capabilities that are of importance to the aerospace community.

The Library and Documentation Services participate in the international exchange between libraries of literature in aerospace technology and related fields. NLR acting as NASA National Centre submits reports from several organizations along with the NLR Technical Publications to the NASA STAR literature data base. On the web site NLR makes available its Technical Publications released since 1997. Most Technical Publications are downloadable in PDF format.
