



## Space Shuttle Discovery at pad for prelaunch preparations

▲ **Shuttle Update:** Space Shuttle Discovery makes its way along the crawlerway from high bay 3 to Launch Pad 39B as the sun rises Wednesday. First motion for the 4-mile journey was at 1:58 a.m. EDT. The vehicle was hard down on the pad at 12:17 p.m.



The Space Shuttle rests on a Mobile Launcher Platform which sits atop a Crawler-Transporter. This is the second rollout of Discovery after being returned to the Vehicle Assembly Building for connection to an improved External Tank. Launch of Discovery on its Return to Flight mission STS-114 is targeted for a launch window extending from July 13 to July 31.
