◆ **Did You Know?** — The Merritt Island National Wildlife Refuge (MINWR) and NASA are partnering to reduce the risk of severe wildfires in the KSC Industrial Area. A timber company is removing a portion of the pine trees in selected areas. This fuel reduction will not prevent wildfires, but will reduce their intensity and provide a safer working environment for fire fighters.
