NASA COMPLETES MUNITIONS SURVEY AT VISITOR CENTER

The Visitor Center at the NASA Wallops Flight Facility has reopened following the completion of a survey for possible unexploded ordnance and explosives on the center's grounds.

No live ammunition or explosives were discovered during the survey conducted January 30 through February 24.

Recently studied historical archives showed that unexploded ordnance items and live munitions may have remained on U.S. Government property at the NASA Visitor Center dating back to when the U.S. Navy conducted operations at the site in the 1950s.

The NASA Visitor Center is open from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m., Thursday through Monday. It is located on Virginia Route 175 about six miles from U.S. Route 13 and five miles from Chincoteague, Va.
