

**Mr. Pessin** joined the space program in 1960 as a propulsion engineer at Marshall Space Flight Center (MSFC). He then spent 8 years as MSFC's mechanical engineering representative to the Michoud Assembly Facility. He returned to MSFC in 1970, where he worked on both the Space Shuttle Main Engines and the Solid Rocket Motor before joining the ET Project office in 1972. He retired from NASA as the Chief Engineer for the ET in December 1997.
