NAOMS Summary

- Provides safety information available from no other source
- Validation indicates sample data reasonable mirror of “reality”
- NAOMS indicates a generally higher incidence of events than comparable data from ASRS, which tends to be higher than comparable FAA data



NAOMS Role




■ Provides:

- Defensible, quantitative, system-wide data
- Reliable measurement of system-wide trends
- Documentation of impact of technologies, procedures, regulations, etc.



NAOMS – Expands quantitative systems and complements qualitative systems
