We have completed our review of the Draft Environmental Impact Statement for the Constellation Project. We agree with the assessments for structures that are National Register eligible or that are already listed as National Historic Landmarks. Furthermore, we agree with consultation between NASA and our office to determine if there will be an adverse effect to these structures and if so, the development of mitigation measures for each site. We also look forward to consulting with your office to determine the National Register eligibility for the two properties, Building 4522 and Building 4530, whose National Register eligibility remains in question.

Finally, there are a vast number of archaeological sites at the Redstone and Marshall facilities. For this reason, we request that we be consulted on land disturbing activities in previously undisturbed areas.
