

FD09 MMT Summary

The MMT met today to review orbiter systems and mission progress. Endeavour and her crew continue to perform in an outstanding manner.

EVA-4 - The team reviewed the plan for your upcoming fourth EVA. The team reviewed all of the trade-offs associated with accommodating the change-out of four P6 batteries on this EVA. The backup timelines, the chemistry behind the EMU LiOH canisters, and the risk posture for the battery that is currently stowed on the IEA, were reviewed by the team. The team agreed the best course of action to successfully complete EVA-4, which is estimated to be 7.5 hours in duration, is to use two LiOH canisters from the contingency EVA stockpile.
