Carolyn & Wendy – Please advise whether the work described as follows requires a PES / REC per Teresa’s e-mail.

Ponding of precipitation runoff under the B2120 canopy posed inconvenience and concern to folks dropping-off / picking up children at the daycare center. Photo P1010020.

The solution was to modify the canopy gutter system and install 2 concrete channels across the landscaped median to drain runoff to lower ground – the grassed area in front of the building. Photos P1010016 and 17.

FOSC Shops implementation was typical of a maintenance action. We prepared an EMI package to instruct Shops and obtain FRB approval.
