

From 101 southbound, take the Moffett Field Exit and turn right at the light.

From 101 northbound, take the Moffett Field Exit and turn right at the light (NOT the Moffett Southgate, Ellis St Exit, which is the exit before Moffett Field).

From 85, take the Moffett Field Exit and turn right at the light.

From 237, take the 101 North Exit and follow the 101 northbound instructions above.

Drive until you get the Moffett Field Main Gate. When able, get into the right lane (but not the right turn lane). Tell the guard you are picking up a School Fieldtrip Vehicle Pass. The guard will direct you into the parking lot on your right. Park and go into the building across from the gate. **ONLY THE TEACHER** needs to go inside to get the vehicle passes for all vehicles. Present a government issued ID (current driver's license works best, US passport is o.k., too). Tell them you are here for the Ames Exploration Encounter in 226 (**REMEMBER:** if you are carpooling, tell them how many vehicle passes you need!!!!). **Before heading in call (650) 604-1110 so the Ames Exploration Encounter Staff can prepare to meet you outside.**


After receiving your pass, exit the parking lot making a right turn to the stop sign (in order to pass back by the guard house). From the stop sign make a right turn and turn into the left lane (closest to the guard house). Present the Vehicle Pass to the guard.

Once past the guardhouse, make an immediate left turn onto Arnold Ave. Present the second guard with your Vehicle Pass

After passing the second guardhouse, turn right onto Bush Circle and follow the circle around (180 degrees) to De France Ave. Turn right onto De France. Follow De France through three stop signs. After the first stop sign you will be driving along side (on your left) of the world's largest wind tunnel. When this building ends, there will be a parking lot and the very next building will be N226 (which is the building you are looking for). You should see an Ames Exploration Encounter Banner on the building and light pole, in addition there is a door painted with a space scene and satellite. You may turn left at the very next stop sign and park anywhere in the parking lot. Busses may park there as well; preferably a little further into the parking lot rather than the first few spots.

You will then be greeted and led up to the AEE.


(Children can bring snacks up to the AEE as they will have a 10 minute snack break and movie.)
