
Dear Mr. Davis:

The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has received the NASA WSTF (Permittee) request for additional time, dated June 4, 2015 and received on June 8, 2015. The Permittee requests additional time to complete the investigation of N-Nitrosodimethylamine (NDMA) in the JER monitoring wells. Significant delays were encountered due to equipment issues and have been resolved as of January 2015. Since then, sampling has continued; however, progress has been much slower than the Permittee anticipated. The Permittee has shown good cause for the extension and NMED hereby grants the Permittee an extension to **September 30, 2015** for the submittal of the investigation report.
