



HABITAT RULES

- Check in is located at the Administrative Offices entrance to the U.S. Space & Rocket Center. Upon check-in, your group will be taken to pay in advance and then move into the habitat.
- **No** food or drink is allowed inside the habitat. If you bring food, it must be sealed to be inside the habitat. You may eat outside the building. Please note we are a **PEANUT FREE** campus.
- Security guards patrol and will be posted in the building during the night in case of any issues.
- Entry and exit to the U.S. Space & Rocket Center will be through the Administrative Offices entrance when the gates are closed and locked. *If you are seen climbing a fence or entering through any other inappropriate means you will be asked to leave and are subject to criminal trespassing charges at the discretion of the security staff.*
- When coming into the habitat at the end of the day's activities, all should be quiet and respectful of the other groups sharing the facility. Excessive noise and/or discipline issues can result in eviction from the habitat with no refund.
- All belongings (including cell phones, MP3 players, etc.) should be locked away in a locker before leaving the room for the day's activities. The U.S. Space & Rocket Center is not responsible for any lost or stolen items.
- All belongings must be removed from the restrooms when you leave, custodial will be cleaning the restrooms and any items left in the restrooms will be discarded.
- Please dispose of any trash in the proper receptacles.



HABITAT RULES

- Females and males are to remain in their respective bays. Males are not allowed in female rooms and females are not allowed in male rooms.
- There is **no** alcohol allowed in the habitat facility. Anyone who is intoxicated upon return to the U.S. Space & Rocket Center will not be allowed on property.
- There is **no** smoking in the vicinity of the Habitat complex. The closest designated smoking area is under the Pathfinder Space Shuttle.
- Please do not use any areas that are marked for staff only.
- Clothing is required inside the habitat facility. Please bring clothes to the restroom with you and change there.
- In the event of severe weather, the habitat is the designated storm shelter for the facility. Please follow any directions given by the building RAs/Management.
- In the event of a fire, exit the nearest exit and move to the area underneath the Pathfinder Space Shuttle.
- Wristbands must be worn at all times while on property. These identify you as authorized to be in the facility.
- You must **move out** by **9 AM** on the day of departure. Luggage cannot be left in the rooms after 9AM. You are responsible for your own luggage past this point.
