





Letter of Recommendation

- Having 1 Letter of Recommendation is required in order for you to be eligible for opportunities.
- You will not be able to select your top 15 opportunities of interest and mentors will not be able to view your application from the applicant pool until your letter has been submitted.
- Once your reference submits the letter in the system, you will automatically be eligible (i.e. no further action is needed).

Request a Letter of Recommendation

Instructions:

- Only one letter of recommendation is required to complete your application (however, you can add as many as you would like).
- Before entering their information below, contact your reference and ask if they are willing to provide a letter of recommendation.
- Tell your reference to expect an email from "ossi@nasa.gov" entitled "NASA - Letter of Recommendation Request".
- Provide the name, relationship, phone number, and email address of the reference in the fields below.
- Click one of the "Send Request" buttons. The system will automatically email a request.
- After you select one of the buttons below to send the request, the system will automatically email a request, and your reference will show up in the table above with a status of "Requested".
- You can submit additional recommendations, if desired, by repeating the same process.

Examples of relevant recommendations include: professors, teaching assistants, academic advisers, faculty from an institution previously attended, teachers from high school (if recent enough), employers/supervisors who can speak of your relevant experience, credentials, academic potential, etc. Please do not have family members submit a letter of recommendation. For fellowship applications, you must have 1 letter of recommendation from a faculty advisor.

Your reference will be requested to provide the following information in their letter: their relationship to you, why they think you merit a NASA opportunity, examples of your abilities and talents, academic and/or extracurricular activities, and leadership capabilities/achievements.


