

**The NASA Excellence in Energy and Water Management Award-** This award provides for one individual award and one group award. Nominations can be made in any one or more of the following three subcategories:

- \* Energy Efficiency- for making significant improvements in energy efficiency or reduction in energy costs for NASA facilities or mobile equipment based on implementing innovative projects, measures, or management techniques;
- \* Water Conservation- for making significant reductions in water use or cost based on implementing innovative projects, measures, or management techniques including, but not limited to, facility retrofits, water reclamation and recycling programs, and water conserving landscaping practices at NASA facilities or through NASA activities, including, but not limited to, such actions as research design, contract approvals, grant approvals, use agreements, and leases; or
- \* Renewable Energy Use- for advancing the use of renewable energy resources, such as solar, wind, and biomass, based on on-site applications or energy supply purchases from new renewable energy sources at NASA facilities or through NASA activities, including, but not limited to, such activities as research design, contract approvals, grant approvals, use agreements, and leases.
