

NASA GLENN RESEARCH CENTER 2020 Volunteer High School Internship Project

Description:

The Volunteer High School Internship Project, sponsored by the Office of Education, allows participants to explore opportunities in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM) as well as business fields and to experience life at the NASA John H. Glenn Research Center (GRC). Participants will be provided with information about various GRC educational resources and programs while working with a GRC scientist, technician, engineer, or administrative professional.

The Volunteer Internship Project is an unpaid internship experience for high school juniors and seniors. The internship will last four (4) consecutive weeks, with each student/mentor combination agreeing on the number of days and hours per week. Each student will work with a NASA Subject Matter Expert (SME) and visit some of GRC's unique facilities and professional administrative offices. Each opportunity will be based on the participant's expressed interests as well as the availability of SMEs and facilities.

Application Deadline and Project Dates:

- Complete application packages must be emailed by Friday, January 10, 2020, to grc-shadowingandinternships@mail.nasa.gov
- Internships will take place between April 6 and May 29, 2020.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be a U.S. citizen
- Must be a high school junior or senior
- Must have a minimum 2.8 cumulative GPA on a 4.0 scale
- Must have their parent or guardian sign the application form
- Must have their guidance counselor or principal sign the application form to verify availability
- Must be available to work for 4 weeks
- Must be able to provide their own transportation to and from NASA GRC

Participants must agree to:

- Adhere to all NASA GRC safety and security requirements
- Attend the entire program
- Provide their own lunch
- Work the hours and days mutually agreed upon with their assigned mentor

Selection Process:

Selection Criteria: Selections will be based on student meeting the eligibility requirements, student essay responses, and a fully completed application.

The application package must be <u>complete</u> and emailed to the following address by **Friday**, **January 10**, **2020**, to be given consideration: <u>grc-shadowingandinternships@mail.nasa.gov</u>. Internship placements are dependent upon the availability of GRC mentors and facilities/offices. Placement in the program is limited. The Office of Education cannot guarantee an internship experience.

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Notification:

Notification of receipt of application will be sent via email. This notification does not imply the acceptance or accuracy of the application. The GRC Office of Education will notify the selected applicants via email and copy the parent/guardian noted on the student's application. Students will be contacted to confirm their attendance. Students may email to inquire about the status of their application.
