On March 10, 2016, the Smithsonian National Air and Space Museum (NASM) will host the opening of the exhibition "A New Moon Rises" in Washington, DC, with a reception starting at 7:00 p.m. until 9:00 p.m. The purpose of the event is to bring together top experts and leaders from all sectors of aviation to celebrate the opening of the exhibit.
