

REIMBURSABLE SPACE ACT AGREEMENT

BETWEEN

THE NATIONAL AERONAUTICS AND SPACE ADMINISTRATION

AMES RESEARCH CENTER

AND

COLLINGS FOUNDATION

Collings Foundation and the National Aeronautics and Space Administration (hereinafter "NASA") executed a Reimbursable Space Act Agreement (hereinafter "Agreement") on May 29, 2002, which incorporated by reference the original agreement between the parties dated May 26, 2000 for the purpose of continuing the annual Bombers at Moffett Air Show Event for an additional year.

Collings Foundation and NASA hereby mutually agree to extend the duration of the Agreement executed May 29, 2002 which expires on May 29, 2003 for one additional year, effective one day following the expiration date of the May 29th agreement or alternatively for one year from the date of the last signature appearing below, in the event that May 29, 2003 has passed at the time this agreement is executed. In the latter event, this agreement shall incorporate the provisions of the expired agreement by reference and shall be effective for one year from the date of the last signature appearing below. The purpose of the extension is to continue activities begun under the agreement executed May 29, 2002.

This modification solely affects the duration of the Space Act Agreement. All other terms and conditions of the May 29, 2002 agreement shall continue in effect as originally agreed, until the expiration of the Agreement, as extended herein.

The May 29, 2002 agreement is attached to this agreement as Exhibit A.
