### 1.2.2 NASA Announces Airborne Pollution and Climate Study

On 06 June 2013, NASA [initiated](#) the Studies of Emissions, Atmospheric Composition, Clouds, and Climate Coupling by Regional Surveys ([SEAC<sup>4</sup>RS](#)) campaign. In August and September 2013, NASA will employ aircraft and sensors to analyze weather patterns and air pollution plumes in the southeastern United States. The goals of the SEAC<sup>4</sup>RS campaign are to:

- Study deep convective transport redistribution of air emissions throughout the troposphere.
- Observe the evolution and transport of gases and aerosols in deep convective outflow.
- Identify aerosol particle effects on climate.
- Gather calibration data for satellite missions.

### 1.2.3 United States Army Releases Net Zero Progress Report

The U.S. Army has [released](#) the "[Net Zero Pilot Installation Initiative Progress Report](#)." The Net Zero program is an Army initiative that focuses on implementation of best practices to reduce energy use, water use, and waste generation. The Army is sponsoring a pilot program in which installations will strive to meet one or more of the following criteria:

- Net Zero Energy facilities produce as much energy as they use.
- Net Zero Water facilities do not deplete local water sources.
- Net Zero Waste facilities having zero landfill use.

The goal of the Net Zero pilot program is to establish 17 Net Zero installations by 2020 and 25 by 2030. The progress report contains information regarding long-term Net Zero implementation strategies.
