

The background above shows Launch Pad 39B at Kennedy Space Center. This pad will launch many different types of rockets as part of a multiuser spaceport. A spaceport helps different kinds of rockets and spacecraft launch in much the same way an airport helps different kinds of airplanes take off and land. The GSDO Program is transforming Kennedy into a spaceport to process and launch the next-generation vehicles and spacecraft designed to achieve NASA's goals for space exploration.
