**Information:** The documentation of the SCAs N905NA and N911NA was conducted in 2012 for NASA's JSC by Archaeological Consultants, Inc. (ACI), under contract to Earth Resources Technology, Inc. (ERT). It was based upon research originated in 2006 as part of a nationwide assessment of NASA's Space Shuttle Program assets, conducted by ACI. The project team consisted of architectural historian, Patricia Slovinac and project manager, Joan Deming (both with ACI). Assistance was provided by Sandra J.
