
**MODIFICATION OF THE
FULLY REIMBURSABLE SPACE ACT AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
THE NATIONAL AERONAUTICS AND SPACE ADMINISTRATION

AND
GEOG2 SOLUTIONS, INC.**

GEOG2 Solutions, Inc. (hereinafter "GEOG2" or "Partner") and the National Aeronautics and Space Administration (hereinafter "NASA") executed a Reimbursable Space Act Agreement on April 30, 2008, as amended by Modification One, effective April 30, 2010 and Modification Two, effective May 16, 2011 (collectively, the "Original Agreement"), for the purpose of collaboration in the area of high-resolution multi-spectral imaging. Each capitalized term used in this Modification, but not defined herein, shall have the meaning ascribed to it in the Original Agreement.

Effective as of the last signature below, NASA and Partner hereby agree to extend the duration of the Original Agreement, which expires on April 30, 2012, for an additional two (2) years. Therefore, the expiration date of the Original Agreement is hereby changed to April 30, 2014.


