

Modification to SAA2-402012
REIMBURSABLE SPACE ACT AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
THE NATIONAL AERONAUTICS AND SPACE ADMINISTRATION
AMES RESEARCH CENTER
AND
SRI INTERNATIONAL

The SRI International (hereinafter "abbreviation for the Other Party's name" and the National Aeronautics and Space Administration (hereinafter "NASA") executed a Reimbursable Space Act Agreement (hereinafter "Agreement") on March 27, 2007 for utilizing Moffett Federal Airfield facilities.

The SRI and NASA hereby mutually agree to extend the duration of the Agreement which expires on July 31, 2007 for an additional 1 (one) year period. The purpose of the extension is to continue activities begun under the original agreement.

This modification affects the duration of the Space Act Agreement and Section 4, Schedule and Milestones

The planned major milestones for the activities defined in section 3 are estimated as follows:

| 10. Aircraft departs for VA | October 22, 2007 |


These milestones will be updated after October 22, 2007.

In the event the agreement sought to be extended has expired, this agreement incorporates the provisions of the expired agreement by reference and keeps that agreement in effect from the date of its expiration, until for one year from the date of the last signature appearing below.
