The Latin name for the Moon is Luna.

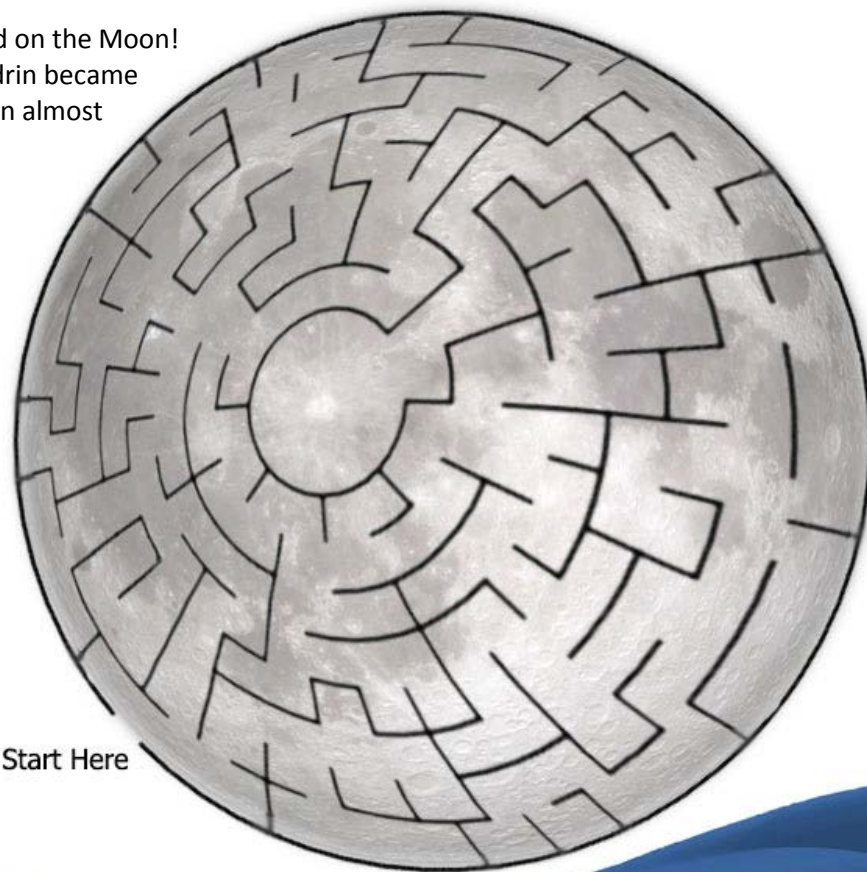
Twelve humans have walked on the Moon!
