STARPORT (JSC EXCHANGE) SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Starport maintains a college scholarship fund to provide financial assistance for dependents of JSC civil service or reimbursable detailees and dependents of JSC Starport Partners (list attached) to attend college.

Starport intends to award two scholarships – one for dependents (children) of civil service employees and one for the dependents (children) of Starport Partner employees. Applicants are evaluated on the basis of academic achievement, financial need, and involvement in school or community activities. The scholarship winners may pursue any course of study leading to a recognized degree, at any accredited college in the country.

AMOUNT OF EACH SCHOLARSHIP

- Individual one-time only scholarships of up to \$4000 are given in the amount of \$2000 per academic semester, (Fall 2025 and Spring 2026), or as determined by Starport.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- The Scholarship Program is open to students who graduate from public, parochial, private high school or complete a home-schooling program in 2025, or students who are currently enrolled in college and are in good academic standing.
- Applicants must have a high school grade point average of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale, or the equivalent.
- Applicants must be a minor dependent (child) of one of the following: JSC civil service employees, NASA civil service employee permanently stationed at JSC, or a JSC Starport Partner employee.
- Minor dependents (children) of civil service employees, or Starport Partner employees, who were medically retired or deceased during the previous year of this application process, and who otherwise would have met these qualifications, are also eligible for consideration.
- Each minor dependent child is eligible to be selected and awarded only one Starport (JSC Exchange) Scholarship.

- For purposes of this program, the minor dependent (child) of a civil service employee or Starport Partner is defined as a child student for which, the employee claims an exemption of his or her Federal income tax or which, is a natural adopted or foster child, for which, the employee furnished the majority of support.

- Completed applications can be emailed to Yvette Villarreal at yvette.j.villarreal@nasa.gov and Bradley Niese at bradley.j.niese@nasa.gov.
 - High School students should furnish an original transcript of their high school grades, and a record of their Scholastic Achievement Test (SAT) or the American College Test (ACT) scores electronically no later than April 30, 2025, to Yvette Villarreal.
 - College Students should furnish their most recent transcript of college grades, as well as a transcript of high school grades and SAT or ACT scores electronically no later than April 30, 2025, to Yvette Villarreal.
 - If the applicant or school is unable to supply an official transcript electronically, we are accepting unofficial transcripts to fulfill the requirement of a completed application. This also applies for any SAT/ACT scores not identified in the unofficial transcript.
- Application forms must be received no later than **April 30, 2025**, to be considered for this year's program.

SELECTION OF WINNERS

- Application forms and scholastic records are evaluated by the Starport Scholarship Committee, composed of at least one member of the Starport Council, one senior JSC employee, and one representative from the Starport Partner participants companies.
- All applicants are notified by email of the results by approximately June 15, 2025, or sooner.
