NASA's CubeSat Launch Initiative (CSLI) provides launch opportunities to a variety of U.S. CubeSat developers. Their small satellite payloads fly as auxiliary payloads on previously planned launches or commercial missions to low Earth orbit and deep space destinations as well as International Space Station deployments.

Accomplishments

- 220+ CubeSat projects selected to date from 100+ organizations, including 40+ states and Puerto Rico
- 148 Initiative CubeSats launched on 43 ELaNa missions
- 35+ CubeSats launched in the past 28 months on 15 missions despite the pandemic

Opportunities

- Facilitating the launch of 18 CubeSats in the remainder of 2022
- Securing Launches of 20 unmanifested/uncontracted CSLI selected CubeSats
