# **Lab Safety**

# **Educator Notes**

# **Learning Objectives**

- Identify potential safety hazards and personal protective equipment in your learning space.
- Establish a lab safety plan and classroom contract to prevent injuries in your learning space.
- Compare safety rules established in your learning space to other workplaces.

#### Introduction

- Pose the following questions to students and discuss each one as a class:
  - Why is it important to have a safe learning space?
  - Have you ever witnessed an injury in a learning space, or have you personally been injured in a learning space? If so, describe what happened and how to prevent it in the future.

### **Activity I**

- Provide each student with a Student Lab Safety Inspection Worksheet. Print these one-sided to give students space for writing in additional hazards/personal protective equipment (PPE).
- Ask each student to individually conduct a learning space safety inspection for all hazards and PPE listed on the worksheet. Encourage students to add hazards or PPE not listed to the back of the page. Following the inspection, each student chooses a partner and compares classroom observations.
- Choose a few student pairs to present their combined observations with the class.

## **Activity II**

- Combine student pairs into groups of four.
- Provide each group with a Student Lab Safety Contract Template.
- Remind students to use their Student Lab Safety Inspection Worksheet to guide their development of a Student Lab Safety Contract.
- Each student group presents their contract to the class. As a class, compare group contracts and choose one or a combination of contracts best fit for their learning space.
- Provide time for each student to adjust their Student Lab Safety Contract to reflect class changes.

# **Suggested Pacing**

#### 55 minutes total

- Introduction 5 min
- Activity I 20 min
- Activity II 20 min
- STEMonstration video 5 min
- Reflection 5 min

#### **Materials**

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#### **STEMonstration Video**

#### Reflection

- Complete the International Space Station comparison column of the Student Lab Safety Inspection Worksheet. Compare the lab safety protocols aboard the International Space Station with the lab safety rules established by the class for their learning space.
- Reinforce the importance of safety in all learning spaces and workspaces.

#### **Extensions**

- Instruct students to continue the conversation at home with family members. Students can inspect their homes for potential safety hazards and discuss safety parameters their parents/guardians must follow at their workplaces.
