THE MISSION:

Space shuttle Discovery's S T S-128 mission is dedicated to the assembly and maintenance of the International Space Station. The seven-member crew will deliver the Multi-Purpose Logistics Module Leonardo, containing life support and science racks, as well as the **Colbert treadmill. A Lightweight Multi-Purpose Experiment Support Structure Carrier,** or LMC, also will be delivered to the space station.

S T S-128 is Discovery's 37th mission, the 128th space shuttle flight, and the 30th mission to the station.

THE CREW:

Commander Rick Sturckow will lead the S T S-128 mission, and Kevin Ford will serve as pilot. **Mission Specialists are Patrick** Forrester, Jose Hernandez, John "Danny" Olivas, Nicole Stott, and **European Space Agency astronaut Christer Fuglesang.**

During the mission, Stott will transfer to the space station to replace Tim Kopra as Expedition 20 flight engineer. Kopra will return home aboard Discovery.
