Ten one-day programs and a 2 week-long summer camps connect a different Girl Scout badge to NASA's work, making difficult concepts more relatable to young minds. The variety of programming will provide opportunities for 250 girls ages 5-17 to participate, with a heavy emphasis on the Scout's largest population of members ages 5-10. In each program, girls will

complete activities to earn a Girl Scout STEM badge, learn about NASA's efforts in the field, and ponder the question, "How can we use what we learned to sustain life on Mars?" Through their participation in this series, girls will develop an interest in STEM, build their self-confidence, develop critical-thinking and problem-solving skills, and learn the value of STEM in our society.

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
