Two free NASA Nights, aimed at students and families from underserved school districts will feature coding workshops in which students navigate a virtual rover, hands-on activities on rockets, air flight and space flight, and educational programming on climate change, the Artemis Mission and the James Webb Space Telescope. This content will be presented in highly engaging and interactive Planetarium experiences, Science on a Sphere, and hands-on workshops. The planetarium presentations, each featuring a NASA

Goddard expert, will be presented twice at each event, with simultaneous Spanish translation. Other planetariums with the same software will be able to view the content live; presentations will also be streamed to YouTube 360 and Facebook Live. The new original planetarium programming on Artemis and the JWST will later be offered as school programming for grades 4-8, both at the planetarium and remotely.

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
