

ROCKON FACULTY WORKSHOP

MAY 19-23, 2025



During the week of May 19-23, NASA Wallops Flight Facility Education Team and the Sounding Rocket Program Office, will be hosting the third annual RockOn faculty workshop for STEM professors across the United States who work at institutions who have never participated in the national RockOn program.

RockOn is a hands-on workshop teaching participants how to create a sounding rocket experiment from scratch over a 5-day period and then launching it into space on a Wallops Sounding Rocket.

The bulk of the workshop will consist of the RockOn experiment build. Experiments will be launched on June 26 as part of the student RockOn launch at Wallops. In addition, faculty will have the opportunity to tour the NASA Wallops Facility, engage with NASA personnel, and learn about additional student and faculty programs across NASA.

Each institution is encouraged to send two STEM faculty. A stipend of \$3,000 will be granted to both faculty to cover transportation, lodging, and meal expenses. The workshop will take place in person, at Wallops Flight Facility. Participants must be a professor for the 2025-2026 academic year at an institution that has never participated in RockOn before. Additionally, all participants must be a U.S. Citizen or Legal Permanent Resident with a valid Green Card.

The application is currently open and will close at 11:59 Eastern on March 14, 2025.
