A recent expansion has allowed Anna's Place NOLA, a youth program in New Orleans, to expand their programming to 5 days a week, and to begin serving a wider audience with a new role as a community center. Through this project, they will incorporate NASA STEM content throughout their programming. In 2022 they kicked off their first summer of NASA ASTRO CAMP ® ; they will build on that experience to expand NASA STEM curriculum to the children, community and neighborhood. They will host public events such as Artemis Launch and Splashdown parties featuring

STEM speakers; talks by local NASA-affiliated researchers; careers in STEM days, highlighting local colleges; partnership with Delgado Community College's maker space and the addition of a laser cutter to the high school program; Science Educator Resource days and NASA ASTRO CAMP ® and GLOBE trainings for K-12 teachers.
