Whichever pavilion (Live Oak, Bluebonnet, or Tranquility Base) that is closest to the tree may be used free of charge for two-hours in conjunction with a memorial tree dedication ceremony. However, if the closest pavilion is not available, or if it rains, the Discovery Room may be used for one-hour free of charge. Gilruth Center conference rooms are also available at half price for memorial tree dedication ceremonies.

Due to budget cuts and reduced staffing, Starport is unable to provide support services (e.g., tents, chairs, tables, PA system, stage, mulch, or shovels, etc.) for site ceremonies.

Please note **memorial trees and markers may NOT be decorated** (i.e., fabric flowers, vases – glass or otherwise, trinkets, wreaths, wind chimes, ornaments, signs, bird houses, ribbons, etc.). Fresh cut flowers may be placed at the tree – please be sure to remove any packaging: paper or cellophane, plastic materials, and rubber bands.
