There are 2 NASA federal jobs and 75^* contractors in the state of Idaho.

For every NASA federal job located in Idaho, an additional 54.5** jobs are supported in the state economy. For every million dollars' worth of economic output generated by NASA federal jobs, an additional \$16** million worth of output is sustained throughout the state economy.
