Subsequent yearly submittals shall update at least 20% of these checkout systems and support equipment items, insuring a 100% coverage of all the listed checkout systems and support equipment every five years. Last submittal of the contract shall include updating the assessments for all of the listed checkout systems and support equipment. New GSE will be evaluated by the contractor and the government at the time of assignment for determination of applicability. In general, new equipment shall be added to the list and evaluated if the total cost exceeds \$100,000.
