Call for Nominations

This is the Center's request for nominations for the 2nd class of inductees to the Glenn Research Center Hall of Fame. In 2015, as part of the National Advisory Committee for Aeronautics Centennial, we established this Hall of Fame. As we celebrate our 75th Anniversary, it is fitting that we mark the occasion by continuing to build the institution to honor individuals who have made our success possible.

The GRC Hall of Fame will honor and recognize those who have built exemplary careers and contributed to our Center's success. Additional classes will be inducted on the occasion of our milestone anniversaries.

To be eligible, the nominee:

- Must have served as a civil servant or contractor at GRC
- Prior to 2006, must have retired, resigned, or became a Distinguished Research Associate (DRA)
- Can be living or deceased

Consideration will be given to:

- Those whose contributions have had the most sustained and far-reaching influence on the mission and direction of the center AND/OR
- Those whose work at the center has generated fundamental advancements in their field AND/OR
- Those who serve as an inspiration to employees through their character and embodiment of the NASA spirit

Nominators must be affiliated with GRC as a current civil servant, contractor or DRA. We encourage nominators to engage with retirees for suggestions and information on their nominations. Nominations should be no longer than two pages and include a summary of the nominee's career and a statement as to why their contributions merit honoring.

Nominations and questions can be submitted via email to Anne Mills, GRC Hall of Fame Coordinator, at anne.mills@nasa.gov, and must be received **by July 15, 2016**. The following must be submitted for a complete nomination package:

- Justification (2 page limit)
- Citation (50 words or less)

The History Office is available for consultation and reference assistance to help those who wish to nominate someone.
