# Predator management to protect T&E nesting shorebirds on Wallops Island

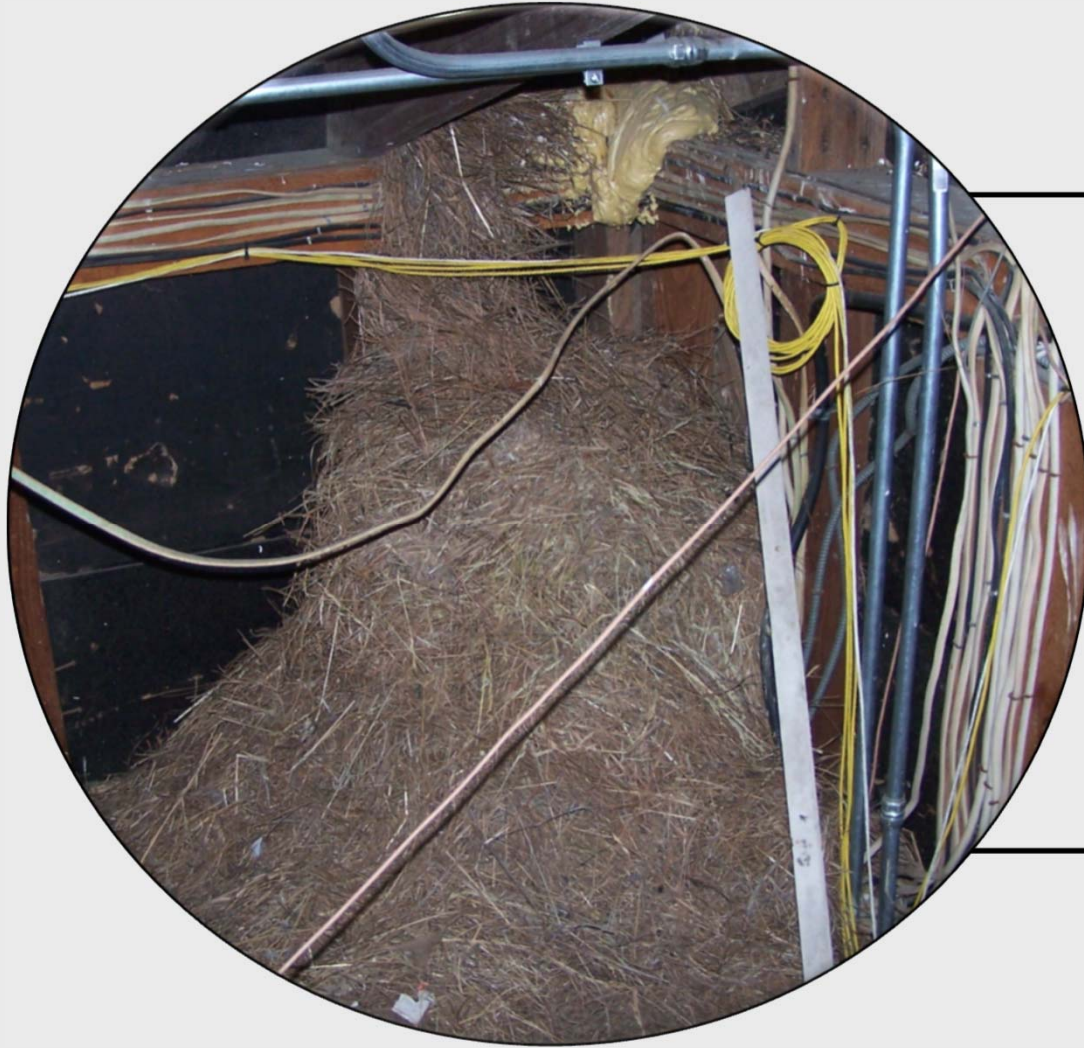
