The full-equipped, mobile classroom, "Mission Control", expands STEM educational programming to rural and underserved urban communities that cannot visit the Museum. The Museum plans to host a series of space festivals for elementary and middle school students. Each space festival is planned in conjunction with local community organizations such as libraries, schools, and science centers to highlight their involvement in STEM education and careers. Festival activities include NASA activities focused on deep space communication,

habitat construction, water filtration, and emerging off-planet careers. Museum education staff collaborate with community educators to share and resources and curriculum before, during, and after the festivals. Parents and students will have access to NASA resources they can continue to explore at home.
