## NOTICE

The National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA) announces its application to the New Mexico Environment Department for a Class 3 Permit modification of the White Sands Test Facility (WSTF) Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Permit (Permit). The modification consists of a change of regulatory status for nine Solid Waste Management Units (SWMUs) and seven ancillary septic tanks to corrective action complete without controls. The expected date of application submittal to the Hazardous Waste Bureau is on or about October 31, 2024. The exact location of WSTF is 12600 NASA Road, Las Cruces, NM 88012. The approximate location of this facility is six miles north of the intersection of NASA Road and US Highway 70, east of Las Cruces, NM.

A 60-day comment period will begin October 21, 2024 and will continue until December 20, 2024. Letters containing the public notice were mailed to all parties listed in the New Mexico Environment Department Hazardous Waste Bureau interested persons list. A public meeting will be held in the Roadrunner room of the Branigan Public Library in Las Cruces, New Mexico from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. on November 13, 2024. The application for Class 3 Permit modification provides documentation that regulatory requirements for closure without controls have been met at each of these sixteen sites (SWMUs 21-27, 29, and 30, and seven ancillary septic tanks). These SWMUs and septic tanks have been permanently removed from service at WSTF.
