SUBJECT: Call for Space Flight Awareness Program Honoree Award Nominations

NASA's Space Flight Awareness (SFA) Program Honoree Award is one of the most prestigious awards presented to civil servants, contractors, and military personnel for dedication to quality work and flight safety. The award includes recognition at a major program event and a VIP tour of a space facility.

The program will host two honoree events in Fiscal Year 2025. The first event will be hosted in conjunction with NASA's SpaceX Crew-10 launch to the International Space Station and the second will coincide with Northrop Grumman's Space Launch System Booster Obsolescence and Life Extension Demonstration Motor-1 Static Test. These events are tentatively scheduled for no earlier than March 2025 at the Agency's Kennedy Space Center and June 2025 at the test viewing site in Layton, Utah, respectively.

The Space Operations Mission Directorate, in coordination with the Exploration Systems Development Mission Directorate, is now accepting nominations for Honoree Award recipients. Nominations should be no longer than one page in length and submitted using the SFA Nomination Form (NF-1738). To nominate an employee for this significant opportunity, the justification should clearly illustrate how the nominee met one or more of the honoree selection criteria. We encourage you to consider the diversity of employees in your workforce as you make your nominations. The nomination form and criteria are available at the program Website: [SFA Honoree Award - NASA](#). Nominations must be submitted to your local SFA representative by noon EST, January 31, 2025. Travel funds to attend the honoree event must be provided by each honoree's respective organizations. Each honoree is permitted to bring one guest; however, guest travel expenses will not be paid for using government funds.
