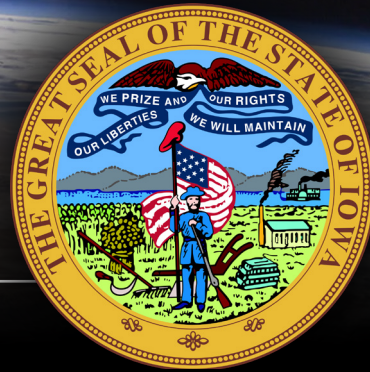

NASA JOBS SUPPORTED

There are 6 NASA federal employees and 369 contractors* in the state of Iowa.

For every NASA civil servant job located in Iowa, an additional 89** jobs are supported in the state economy. For every million dollars' worth of economic output generated by NASA civil service employees, an additional \$41** million worth of output is sustained throughout the state economy.
