#### **NASA JOBS SUPPORTED**

There are 5 NASA federal employees and 430 contractors\* in the state of New Hampshire.

For every NASA civil servant job located in New Hampshire, an additional 134\*\* jobs are supported in the state economy. For every million dollars' worth of economic output generated by NASA civil service employees, an additional \$65.4\*\* million worth of output is sustained throughout the state economy.


