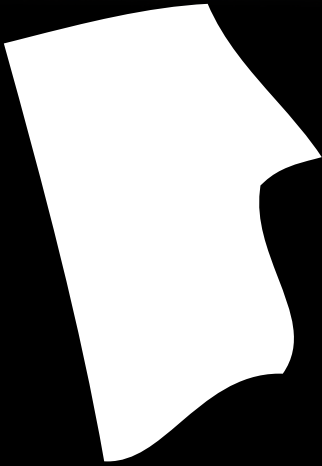

NASA JOBS SUPPORTED

There are 3 NASA federal employees and 57 contractors* in the state of Rhode Island.

For every NASA civil servant job located in Rhode Island, an additional 35** jobs are supported in the state economy. For every million dollars' worth of economic output generated by NASA civil service employees, an additional \$16** million worth of output is sustained throughout the state economy.
