NASA's Space Operations Mission Directorate is now accepting fiscal year (FY) 2026 nominations for Space Flight Awareness (SFA) Program awards, including Flight Safety, Honoree, Management, Silver Snoopy, Supplier, Trailblazer, and Team.

The SFA program highlights the vital role each employee plays in promoting astronaut safety and mission success. We encourage you to take this opportunity to recognize individuals, teams, and suppliers for their exceptional contributions.

Employees considered for SFA awards must meet the program's criteria, which are available on the SFA webpage: <https://www.nasa.gov/space-flight-awareness/>. Nominations should be typewritten, no longer than one page, and submitted using the SFA Nomination Form (NASA Form 1738), with relevant criteria included.

Deadlines to submit award nominations to your local SFA representative are as follows:

- Silver Snoopy – Feb. 2, 2026\*
- Flight Safety, Management, Supplier, Trailblazer, and Team – March 2, 2026
- Honoree – June 1, 2026

\*Note, flown NASA astronauts may submit Silver Snoopy nominations year-round.

Additionally, the Honoree Award includes the opportunity to attend a major program event, recognition at a ceremony and a VIP tour of a NASA facility. Travel to the event must be funded by each honoree's organization. Each honoree may bring one guest; guest travel expenses are not covered by government funds. One honoree event is planned for FY 2026 at Kennedy Space Center held in conjunction with the launch of the Fall 2026 crew rotation mission to the International Space Station.
