Reid Wiseman, the commander of the Artemis II mission, is a naval aviator and no stranger to flying powerful machines. He was selected as an astronaut in 2009 and spent five and a half months aboard the International Space Station in 2014. Reid was Chief of the Astronaut Office before being selected to command Artemis II.

Victor Glover, the pilot of Artemis II, is also a naval aviator. He's flown more than 40 aircraft and racked up more than 3,000 flight hours. In 2020 and 2021, he served as the pilot on the SpaceX Crew-1 flight and was flight engineer for the Expedition 64 mission. Victor has spent 168 days in low Earth orbit.

Christina Koch, Artemis II mission specialist, began at NASA's Goddard Space Flight Center in Greenbelt, Maryland, as an electrical engineer. As a flight engineer on the International Space Station from March 2019 to February 2020, Christina set the record for the longest single spaceflight by a woman with 328 days in space.

Jeremy Hansen, Artemis II mission specialist, was a fighter pilot in the Canadian Armed Forces, and the Canadian Space Agency selected him to become an astronaut in 2009. Jeremy is the first Canadian to lead the training of a NASA astronaut class, and when we fly Artemis II, he will become the first Canadian to go to the Moon.
