SciENcv Requirements for NASA Disclosure Forms

PURPOSE: To inform NASA grant and cooperative agreement applicants and recipients about the launch of NASA biographical sketch and current and pending (other) support disclosure forms on the Science Experts Network Curriculum Vitae ([SciENcv](#)) platform, with a 60-day transition period where both the current Microsoft Word fillable forms and SciENcv forms will be accepted. After the transition period, only SciENcv-developed forms will be accepted for all applications.

BACKGROUND: Per *NASA Grant and Cooperative Agreement Manual* ([GCAM](#)) sections 10.5, Biographical Sketches, and 10.6, Current and Pending (Other) Support Disclosures, all senior/key persons listed on a NASA grant or cooperative agreement proposal must submit disclosure forms with each proposal. Currently, these forms are completed using Microsoft Word templates available on the NASA Office of Procurement, Grant Operations Management ([GOM](#)) website.

Beginning **June 25, 2026**, applicants will be able to access and complete the NASA-specific biographical sketch and current and pending (other) support forms within SciENcv, a National Institutes of Health, National Center for Biotechnology Information (NCBI) system that supports the creation, management, and sharing of standardized disclosure forms. NASA will accept disclosure forms in either the Word fillable format or SciENcv format until August 31, 2026. Starting **September 1, 2026**, NASA will only accept the NASA-specific, SciENcv-developed forms in grant and cooperative agreement proposals.

- **June 25 – August 31, 2026:** Applicants have the option to submit disclosure forms via either:
 - Word fillable forms downloaded from the GOM website or
 - SciENcv-generated forms.
- **Effective September 1, 2026:** NASA will only accept the NASA-specific, SciENcv-developed forms. Word-based forms will no longer be accepted.
