

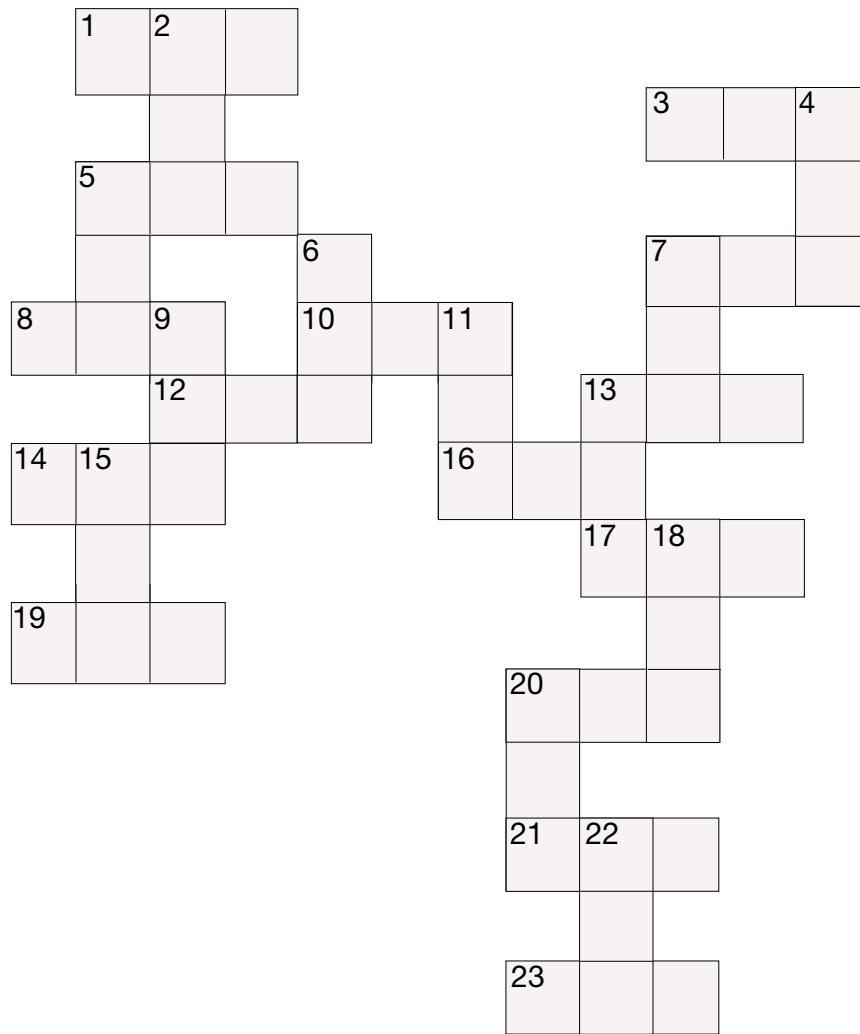
Smart Skies Crossword Puzzle

Background Information

Airport Codes are shortened to make finding an airport easier worldwide. Flight planning, baggage care, and air traffic control can use these codes as an efficient way to communicate.

In the early days of aviation, US airports used two letters but over time, mostly transitioned to three letter codes. The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) designates three to five character codes, with most major airports having three letter codes. How well do you know your US airports? 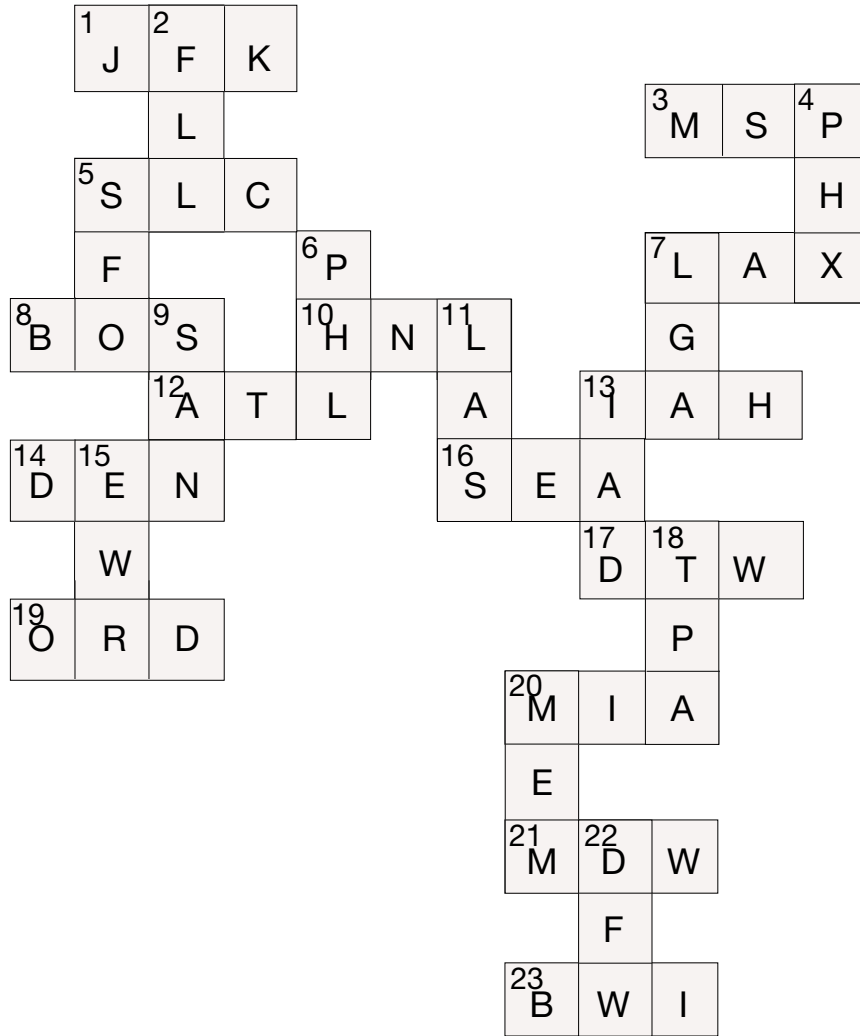
